

# Entry Requirements

## September 2021

Please note that the minimum entry requirements for the Cheadle Hulme High School Sixth Form are 6 GCSEs at Grade 6, including English Language or Literature and Mathematics.

In addition, some subjects have specific entry requirements.

<b>Art &amp; Design</b>	Grade 7 in GCSE Art and Design
<b>Biology</b>	Grade 7 in in GCSE Biology or Combined Science. In addition, due to the content of the new GCSE specifications, we recommend that students have taken separate sciences at GCSE
<b>Chemistry</b>	Grade 7 in GCSE Chemistry or Combined Science and a minimum Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics. In addition, due to the content of the new GCSE specifications, we recommend that students have taken separate sciences at GCSE
<b>Computer Science</b>	Grade 7 Mathematics. GCSE Computer Science is not required but would be beneficial for this course
<b>Design &amp; Technology: Product Design</b>	Minimum Grade6/ Merit 2 in either GCSE Design and Technology/ BTEC Engineering and a minimum Grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics
<b>Drama &amp; Theatre</b>	Grade 6 in GCSE Drama. Students who have not studied GCSE Drama will need to be able to prove a performance level that is appropriate for A Level
<b>Economics</b>	Grade 7 in English Language and Mathematics. GCSE Economics is not required
<b>English Language</b>	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language
<b>English Literature</b>	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language and English Literature

<b>Geography</b>	Grade 7 in GCSE Geography
<b>History</b>	Grade 7 in GCSE History
<b>Law</b>	No additional entry requirements
<b>Mathematics</b>	Minimum Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics
<b>Mathematics (Further)</b>	Minimum Grade 8 in GCSE Mathematics
<b>Mathematics (Core) Level 3 Certificate</b>	No additional entry requirements
<b>Media Studies</b>	No additional entry requirements
<b>Modern Foreign Languages (French/ German/ Spanish)</b>	Grade 7 GCSE in the chosen language
<b>Photography</b>	Grade 7 in either GCSE Art or GCSE Photography
<b>Physical Education</b>	Grade 7 in GCSE Physical Education
<b>Physics</b>	Grade 7 in GCSE Physics or Combined Science and a Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics. In addition, due to the content of the new GCSE specifications, we recommend that students have taken separate sciences at GCSE. Due to the similarities between subjects and future progression, students wishing to take A Level Physics must also take A Level Mathematics
<b>Psychology</b>	Grade 6 in GCSE Additional Science or a Separate Science GCSE
<b>Fashion &amp; Textiles</b>	Grade 7 in either GCSE Art or Textiles
