Dear Parents/Carers

The summer term has been particularly busy culminating in new and exciting ventures for the students at CHHS. The Duke of Edinburgh Bronze and Gold expeditions have been ongoing in addition to a number of trips including PGL for Year 7, a Maths trip to Bletchley Park and an English trip to the Imperial War Museum. We also have many of our Year 8 students experiencing France, Germany and Spain during the last week of term.

As always there has been a celebratory feel to the end of the term – Sports Day, House Events, the Music Concert, Limelights and Spotlights productions, Sports Presentation Evening and the House KS3 Rewards Evening have confirmed that. We would like to take this opportunity to thank all parents/carers who have come along and supported the students.

This year we have planned a three-day Culture and Creativity Festival from Tuesday 17th to Thursday 19th July. This forms part of our commitment to ensure that all students have the opportunity to participate in culturally enriching and creative activities. There will be visiting artists, authors, musicians and actors delivering presentations and workshops and while the timetable will run as normal, teachers will embrace the spirit of the festival by tailoring their lessons to ensure that they have a more creative approach to the delivery of their subject. CHHS School Uniform 2018-19

Uniform Requirements for all students

- Black jacket with new CHHS logo
- White shirt, long or short sleeved, with pointed collar. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- School tie appropriate to a student's House
- V-necked, plain, black, long sleeved jumper
- Plain black shoes. Trainers and boots are not acceptable, nor is canvas footwear.
- Black skirt with new CHHS logo (two styles)
- Black trousers. Trousers and shoes must be practical and formal, not fashion items.
- Trousers must be tailored; neither tight nor baggy; nor excessively flared; not denim or corduroy
- Black socks, black or neutral tights must be worn
- Hijabs must be plain black or plain white
- House T-shirt – can be purchased from school via ParentPay or PayPoint

From September 2018, CHHS phased in a new Black PE kit. This kit must be worn by Year 7 and Year 8 students from September 2018**

Black PE Kit for Year 7 and Year 8 from September 2018

- Black & Grey reversible rugby shirt (boys only) – embroidered CHHS logo
- Black fleece (girls only) – embroidered CHHS logo
- Black polo shirt – embroidered CHHS logo
- Black shorts or skort – embroidered CHHS logo
- Black sports socks or White ankle/trainer socks
- Training shoes – pumps/Vans/Converse footwear will not be allowed for PE lessons
- Plastic or rubber studded football boots/astroturf trainers
- Shin pads for Football/Hockey
- A mouth guard is recommended for Hockey
- Black tracksuit bottoms (optional)
- Black fitness leggings (optional)

**Students that currently wear the Maroon and Black PE kit may do so until they finish Year 11 at CHHS. The uniform suppliers will have a limited stock of the maroon kit until it is phased out by the summer of 2021. Any student may wear the black PE kit.
