Period of Covid-19 isolation home learning

We clearly accept and understand that students may have to take time off school for illness or enforced isolation. During these times, when well enough to do so, students will want to complete a period of home learning. This communication is intended to let you know where students can find their home learning tasks during an initial period of school absence.


General advice with regards to home learning

We understand how very different each set of family circumstances can be and the pressures involved with continuing with home learning. If your child is well enough and able to continue with home learning during this period of isolation we suggest the following advice:




- Where possible keep a routine and perhaps follow the school timetable.
- Work on particular subjects / tasks for the equivalent time as their timetable, rather than working until a task is finished.
- Take regular breaks, especially if their home learning involves increased time using an electronic device.

Above all else though, your child should only continue with home learning if they are well enough to do so. Their health is the most important aspect of this whole situation.
