Note from the Director of Sixth Form

In Sixth Form this week, the focus has been very much on exams; the remaining A Level exams have taken place with the very last ones on Friday. Thank you to all our students and their parents/carers for their ongoing support during the exam season. Year 12 exams and study leave will start on Monday and will continue into the following week. Year 12 students are welcome to make use of the study facilities in Sixth Form and the Study Centre will remain open until 6.00pm each evening. Professional dress, including a lanyard, should be worn when students come into school for exams or to study and students should remember to sign in and out when entering and leaving the site.

Although the focus this week has been on exams, in this week's assembly, delivered by Miss Rainford, we did look ahead to the next stage in the Life after Laurus programme. Students have been attending group meetings with their reference writer to discuss super-curricular activities and reading which will enhance their UCAS application and which is vital for question 2 of the personal statement. Students have continued to work on their personal statements using the OSCAR platform for support and will attend a 1-1 meeting with their reference writer early in the autumn term (for competitive entry applicants this will take place before the summer break). During the assembly, Miss Rainford also spoke about UCAS predicted grades and how these are decided.
