Our school has been taking part in a project that runs in partnership with Manchester Safeguarding Board and Greater Manchester Police since 2019.

The project, Operation Encompass, has been designed to provide early reporting to school of any domestic abuse incidents that occur outside of school, but which might have an impact on a child attending school the following day. This information will be shared, by the police, on school days during the school term. When incidents occur on a Friday, Saturday or Sunday, the police will contact the relevant school the following Monday.

Nominated members of school staff, known as Key Adults, have been trained to liaise with the police. At Cheadle Hulme High School our Key Adults are Miss Ballard and Mrs Geddis. They use information that has been shared with them, in confidence, to ensure that the school is able to support children and their families. Information will be shared where it is identified that a child or young person was present, witnessed or was involved in a domestic abuse incident.

We always endeavour to offer the best support possible to our students, and their families, and believe that Operation Encompass is beneficial and supportive for all concerned.
